

SPR Nordic Cup ***NEZ*** ***North European Trophy*** ***Sporting Regulations 2019***

1. Championship

This is the Sporting & Technical Regulations for:

SPR Nordic Cup NEZ North European Trophy 2019 (Short: **SPRNC NEZ Trophy 2019**).

These Sporting & technical Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on the NEZ web-site www.fia-nez.eu, where possible changes, bulletins etc., will be published.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

The **SPRNC NEZ Trophy 2019** is handled by the NEZ Racing Commission in association with respectively ASN's Racing Commissions or their representatives within the NEZ and SPR Nordic Management. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from hosting ASN and the promoter SPR Nordic Management.

Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

3. Eligible Drivers

The events will be national and are open to drivers with an appropriate, valid driver's license, including starting permission from their respectively ASN.

Only drivers with a license issued by an ASN within the NEZ-countries can score points in the Championship.

4. Eligible Cars

Cars must fulfill requirements of the SPR Nordic Cup Sporting and Technical Regulations 2019.

5. Championship Rounds 2019

04 – 05 May, Mantorp Park, Sweden

25 – 26 May, Kinnekulle, Sweden

05 – 07 July, Ring Knutstorp, Sweden

17 – 18 Aug, Rudskogen, Norway

21 – 22 Sep, Falkenberg, Sweden

6. Points

Each heat will count towards the Trophy, point will be awarded based as below:

The winner of the **SPRNC NEZ Trophy 2019** is the driver/drivers who has the highest total score from all heats during the season. In the case of two or more drivers has the same total score, the higher position will be given to the driver with the best position in the last raceheat and then in the second last raceheat etc.

7. Entries

Competitors are responsible for sending in correct and complete entry according to SPR Nordic Cup Sporting and Technical Regulations 2019.

8. Free Practice, Qualifying and Race

According to each event/organizer's time schedule during the race weekend and the SPR Nordic Cup Sporting and Technical Regulations 2019.

10. Tire and tire limitation

11. Time-keeping

All competitors must have their own or rented time-keeping transponder mounted and working when the car is on the track (free practice, qualifying and heats).
