

SPORTING REGULATIONS 2019

1. Championship

This is the Sporting Regulations for Legend Cars NEZ North European Trophy 2019 (Short: NEZ Legends 2019). These Sporting Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on the NEZ web-site: www.fia-nez.eu where possible changes, bulletins etc, will be published.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

NEZ Legends 2019 is handled by the NEZ Racing Commission in association with respective ASN's Racing Commissions or their representatives within the NEZ. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from hosting ASN, Supplementary Regulations of each Round and the Regulations set by the Promoter – "Autosporta klubs X sports" (Latvia). Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

3. Eligible Drivers

The events will be national and are open to drivers with an appropriate, valid driver's license, including starting permission from their respective ASN. Only drivers with a license issued by an ASN within the NEZ-countries can score points in the NEZ Legends 2019.

4. Eligible Cars

Events in the Championship are exclusively limited to Legend Cars type conforming to the NEZ Technical Regulations for Legend Cars (https://batcc.eu/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/technical-regulations-2019_legendcars.pdf)

5. Championship Rounds

- I Round: 10th – 12th, May 2019 (Riga, "Bikernieki Circuit", Latvia)
- II Round: 7th – 9th, June 2019 (Hämeenlinna, "Ahvenisto Racing Circuit, Finland)
- III Round: 28th – 30th, June 2019 (Parnu, "Auto24ring", Estonia)
- IV Round: 21st – 22nd, September 2019 (Alastaro, Finland)

Each round will consist of one qualifying and minimum two finals.

6. Points scoring and determination of the Trophy holder

- 6.1. In the NEZ Legends 2019 there will be one Trophy holder of the series.
- 6.2. Every round and each final actually held will count towards the Trophy.
- 6.3. Points will be awarded per each final throughout the season based on the following table:

- 6.4. In order to be classified in the certain final, the participant must complete at least 75% (seventy five percent) of the distance in the race final completed by the winner of the race. DNQ status is determined to the participants completed less than 75% (seventy five percent) of the distance in the race final completed by the winner.
- 6.5. The Driver who collects the greatest number of points will be determined as the Champion.

- 6.6. If two or more participants finish the NEZ Legends 2019 with the same number of points, the higher place in the overall standings shall be awarded to:
- the driver who is the holder of the greatest number of the highest places of the finals in the class throughout the season;
 - if the number of the highest places is the same, the most second place finishes will be announced the winner;
 - this process will repeat itself through all available finishing positions until a winner is produced;
 - if this process fail to produce the winner, the driver who gets higher place in the last final of the last round will get higher place in the overall standings.

7. Entries

- In order to be eligible to score series points the Competitors/Drivers must enter the NEZ Legends 2019 series. The entry has to be made via web site of the promoter of the series: www.batcc.eu
- Competitors are responsible for sending (directly or indirectly via local ASNs) in correct and complete entry.
- The registration for the series is open on 25th of March 2019 and closes one day prior the last round.
- The Championship will become legitimate unless there are minimum number of entries - 10 (ten) throughout the season.

8. Free Practice, Qualifying and Finals

- Free practice and qualifying sessions, as well as the race finals are always held in accordance with the official organizer`s time-table of each round.
- Grid for final No 1 will be determined by the time set in the qualifying session (the driver, who has reached the fastest qualifying laptime, will start at the pole position in the final No 1).
- Grid for final No 2 will be determined by the best time set in final No 1 (the driver, who has reached the fastest laptime in final No 1, will start at the pole position in the final No 2).
- Grid for final No 3 (and further on) will be determined by the best time set in final No 2 (the driver, who has reached the fastest laptime in final No 2, will start at the pole position in the final No 3).

9. Time-keeping

All competitors must have their own or rented time-keeping transponder mounted and working when the car is on the track (free practice, qualifying and race).

10. Entry fee for Championship and Rounds

- The entry fee for NEZ Legends 2019 series is set to be 50,00 EUR (VAT excluded) which has to be paid before closing the Championship registration.
